In the Men’s Division, Phil Bartone won his first Colonia championship defeating Craig Gatto for the Club’s 67th crown



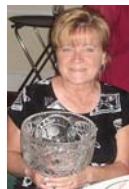

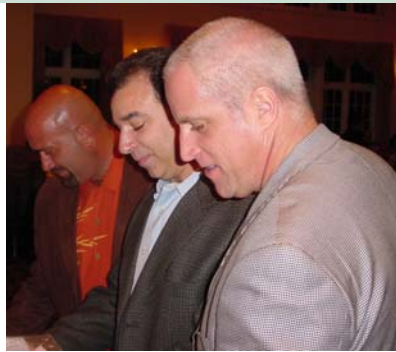
